She is also Director of the academic program at the Académie Diplomatique International in Paris. Prior to that, she was Associate research fellow at the Centre d'études et de recherche international (CERI) at Sciences-Po Paris; senior adviser on international cooperation to the French national research council (CNRS) and visiting fellow at the Collège de France.

From 1999 to 2005, as Senior Program Officer, she headed the Governance and International Cooperation program at the Ford Foundation office for the Middle East and North Africa, based in Cairo where she had overall responsibility for support to research institutions, NGOs and public agencies in the region, and special responsibility for initiating and supporting joint Palestinian projects on peace and track II meetings.

Prior to moving to Cairo, she established and directed the Middle East Program at the Institut Français des Relations Internationales (IFRI) in Paris from 1981 to 1998 and was Associate Professor of International Relations at Paris University. At IFRI, she was chief coordinator and moderator of a series of dialogues between Israelis and Palestinians from 1994 to 1998.

She holds a PhD in Political Science from Sciences-Po in Paris.

She has authored books and articles on conflicts in the Middle East, regional security, the Palestinian question, political developments in Arab societies and the relationship between religious authority and political authority in the Muslim world.

Her latest book Abattre les murs (Breaking Walls) was published in France in February 2008.
